THE ELSIE ALEXANDER PRO-LIFE WORK SCHOLARSHIP **(Sponsored by the Lethbridge and District Pro-Life Association)**

The Elsie Alexander Pro-Life Work Scholarship was instituted in 2011 by the Lethbridge and District Pro-Life Association in recognition of the leadership and many years of dedicated service of Elsie Alexander to the Pro-Life Movement at the local, provincial, and national levels.

Purpose of the Scholarship

To encourage young people to

1. learn more about the pro-life movement
2. reward involvement in pro-life activities
3. participate in voluntary activities in their school, church and/or community
4. become discerning of society's values

Value of the Scholarship

1. Five hundred dollars (\$500) to be awarded to the winner.
2. Payment and certificate of recognition will be arranged with the student or will be presented to the winner(s) at the Hike for Life (June 8, 2024). If there is a problem with that date, other arrangements can be made for a suitable time and location.

The Scholarship Contest Rules

1. **Pro-Life Work/Volunteer Activities** – State your past and present pro-life work/volunteer activities that promote a culture of life. Include a personal biography of pro-life activities, and based on past experiences, suggest new ideas for getting more people involved in promoting life.
2. **Self-Profile and References**
 - a. Submit a self-profile (200-400 words) that describes your motive and interest behind your involvement in pro-life activities and how this will shape your future defense of life.
 - b. Obtain **two** letters of reference (emailed to us, directly from the author). Your references should be from people who have observed or are aware of your involvement in pro-life activities

Eligibility

The entrant must be a student in his/her graduating year at a high school and living in the administrative region of Lethbridge and District Pro-Life (west to the BC border, east to the Saskatchewan border, south to the U.S. border and north to Vulcan/Nanton).

Administration of the Scholarship

1. A committee selected by the board of Lethbridge & District Pro-Life Association will administer the contest and constitute the panel of judges.
2. Entries will be judged between May 25- June 3, 2024, and the winner will be announced and presented to at announced and presented to at the Lethbridge and District Hike for Life on June 8, 2024. If there is a problem with that date, arrangements can be made to present the award to the student at their school assembly or another location.
